Advisory Circular

Subject: BCAR-M Issue 02, Revision 00.

1. Purpose.

This advisory circular (AC) provides information on the latest amended BCAR-M Issue 02, Revision 00.

2. Background.

The South Asian Regional Initiative (SARI) has developed a harmonized regulation SARI Part-M for 'Continuing Airworthiness Requirements' to be adopted by its Member State Countries. Being a signatory member state to SARI, BCAA has amended BCAR-M Issue 01, Revision 02 and published this regulation as BCAR-M Issue 02, Revision 00. (*Refer Appendix I for Summary of changes*)

3. Guidance and information.

The newly amended BCAR-M Issue 02, Revision 00 has been uploaded to BCAA website (www.bcaa.gov.bt) and it becomes effective from *01 April 2021*.

Therefore, all the concerned stakeholders are hereby requested to visit BCAA website for latest and current BCAR-M and amend your manuals affected by this revision accordingly.
