Guidance Note 1: Introduction

- All sections of the application form must be completed by the applicant. Any section that is not applicable should be marked as "N/A."
- ➤ BCAA will not accept applications that are incomplete or submitted without a duly filled BCAA Form 19. Applicants are required to visit the BCAA office only after duly completing the BCAA Form 19.
- For initial applications, applicants must submit a coloured passport-size photograph in formal attire (Gho or Kira for Bhutanese applicants) along with a scanned signature.
- The application form must be completed in **BLOCK CAPITAL LETTERS**.
- > Submitting a clear and accurately completed application form, together with all relevant supporting documents, will facilitate timely processing of licences, ratings, and certificates, minimising the risk of errors, rejections, or delays.
- Renewal applications must be submitted at least one month prior to the licence expiry date.
- A minimum of 10 working days after the receipt of application shall be allowed before you may query about your application.
- > Applicants are advised to refer to BCAR-66, available on the BCAA website and other applicable BCAA regulations to ensure compliance with all relevant requirements for their application.

Please note that failure to submit a correctly completed application form, with the required supporting documents will lead to the return of your application.
