**Airworthiness Circular**  
**AC-66-01**

Validation of Foreign Licence of Aircraft Maintenance Engineers

*Issue 01 dated 08 April 2026*

---

**1. General**

The Circular is issued by the Head of Authority of Bhutan Civil Aviation Authority (BCAA), in exercise of power conferred by the Section 52 of Civil Aviation Act of Bhutan 2016, to communicate safety-related requirements not fully addressed in existing published regulation, or to provide advice, guidance and information on regulation, requirements or standards. The provision of this Circular are complementary to the requirements of respective BCAR “as amended” and does not supersede or replace the associated regulatory requirement.

Circulars issued may be permanent or interim in nature, and are intended to ensure continued compliance, standardisation, and effective oversight of aviation safety. The compliance with this circular is mandatory.

**2. Purpose**

The purpose of this Circular is to establish the requirements for issuance of certificate of validation (herein referred to as ‘the certificate’) for foreign aircraft maintenance engineer (AME) licenses, issued by a Contracting State of ICAO.

**3. Applicability**

This Circular is applicable to maintenance organisations approved in accordance with BCAR-145 or BCAR-M Subpart F that are located within Bhutan.

**4. Cancellation**

This is the first Circular issued on the subject.

**5. References**

This Circular relates specifically to BCAR-66, BCAR-145 and BCAR-M.



## 6. Eligibility

- (a) An applicant for a certificate shall;
  - 1) not be less than 21 years of age;
  - 2) holds a valid foreign AME licence where the validity period shall be not less than six (6) months on the date of the application;
  - 3) have the aircraft type endorsed in the foreign AME licence; and
  - 4) have at least three years of experience in exercising privileges of foreign AME licence.
  - 5) have successfully passed the airworthiness regulation exam conducted by BCAA.
- (b) The FAA A&P Certificate, ICAO state Certificates based on the FAA Certificate and licences from ICAO states with open Significant Safety Concerns in Personnel Licensing (PEL) are not recognised.
- (c) Ratings are only issued for aircraft types that are type accepted by BCAA.

## 7. Application for Certificate

- (a) General
  - 1) Each application shall be supported by documentation to demonstrate compliance with the applicable requirements of this Circular.
  - 2) BCAA will issue, or renew a certificate upon being satisfied that the applicant is a fit person to hold a certificate and has furnished the evidences and passed the examinations and tests as may be required of him, for the purpose of establishing that the applicant has sufficient knowledge, experience, competence, and skill in aircraft maintenance.
- (b) An applicant for issuance of a certificate shall submit the application form BCAA Form 19V accompanied by the prescribed fee together with the following documentation;
  - 1) certified true copy of the Passport;
  - 2) certified true copy of valid foreign AME licence;
  - 3) evidence of type training;
  - 4) evidence of training on human factors;
  - 5) evidence of training on safety management system;
  - 6) evidence of passing the BCAA Airworthiness Regulation Exam (Written and Oral);
  - 7) evidence of exercising certification privileges of the foreign AME licence for at least three years;
  - 8) evidence of need and acceptable justification to hold the certificate by the person specified in paragraph 7(d) of this Circular; and
  - 9) submit a recent passport size photograph (45mm x 35mm).
  - 10) submit psychoactive drug test result.



- (c) An applicant for renewal of a certificate shall submit the application form BCAA Form 19V accompanied by the prescribed fee, together with a certified true copy of valid foreign AME licence, a recent passport size photograph and psychoactive drug test report.
- (d) An application under paragraph 7(b) and 7(c) of this Circular shall be made by a nominated postholder who is responsible for the maintenance function or the quality function of a BCAR-145 or BCAR-M Subpart F organisation.

## 8. Issuance of a Certificate

BCAA may issue a certificate (BCAA Form 26V), in form and manner established in Appendix I of this Circular, if BCAA is satisfied that the applicant has fulfilled all applicable requirements under this Circular.

## 9. Validity Period

- (a) The certificate shall be valid for a period not exceeding one year or the same as the validity period of the foreign AME licence, whichever is earlier.
- (b) The certificate is valid if the holder of a certificate is engaged by a person under paragraph 7(d) of this Circular.

## 10. Additional Requirements

- (a) The holder of a certificate shall not issue maintenance release if the certificate is suspended or revoked by BCAA.
- (b) The categories and type ratings granted in the certificate will not exceed the categories and type ratings, including limitation of the foreign AME licence.
- (c) A holder of a certificate shall carry the certificate with the foreign AME licence and have to be presented when requested by BCAA.

## 11. Effectivity

This Circular is effective from 08 April 2026.
