Circular

Subject: BCAR-47 Issue 01, Revision 00

1. Purpose

This circular is to inform all the organizations regarding the promulgation of BCAR-47 Aircraft Nationality and Registration Mark Issue 01 Revision 00.

2. Background

This requirement is developed using ICAO Annex 7 as a basis and specifies eligibility criteria for aircraft ownership and details the process for issuing Certificates of Registration. Furthermore, the document mandates the allocation and display of nationality and registration marks, requires the carriage of fireproof identification plates, and outlines the specific conditions under which an aircraft may be deregistered or have its registration revoked.

3. Guidance and Information

The existing airworthiness requirements prescribed under BCAR–Aircraft Nationality and Registration Marks, dated 1 October 2010, together with the relevant provisions concerning aircraft nationality and registration marks contained in BAR-AW, dated 1 October 2012, will be repealed with effect from 1 September 2026. Accordingly, all organisations shall ensure that their aircraft nationality and registration mark arrangements are managed in accordance with this requirement following the repeal.
