Circular

Subject: BCAR-M Issue 02, Revision 02

1. Purpose

This circular is to inform all the organizations regarding the promulgation of BCAR-M Continuing Airworthiness Requirement Issue 02 Revision 02.

2. Background

BCAR-M Issue 02 Revision 02 introduces the requirement for an Airworthiness Review Certificate (ARC) as part of the continuing airworthiness framework. The revision also clarifies the authorised release certificates that are recognised as equivalent to the BCAA Form 1 for the purposes of demonstrating compliance with the applicable requirements.

3. Guidance and Information

The existing BCAR-M Issue 02 Revision 01, dated 31 December 2022, will be repealed with effect from 1 September 2026. As a transitional measure, all approved BCAR-M Subpart G organisations are required to amend their respective expositions to comply with BCAR-M Issue 02 Revision 02 and submit the amended exposition to BCAA for acceptance no later than 1 March 2027.

Following BCAA's acceptance of the amended exposition, aircraft under the continuing airworthiness management of the respective BCAR-M Subpart G organisation will be eligible for the issuance of an unlimited Certificate of Airworthiness (CoA) in accordance with BCAR-21.A.181, together with a valid Airworthiness Review Certificate (ARC) in accordance with BCAR-M Subpart I. Until the amended exposition has been accepted by BCAA, the aircraft shall continue to be issued with a Certificate of Airworthiness valid for one year in accordance with the applicable provisions of BCAR-21 Issue 01 Revision 00. During this transitional period, the organisation shall also continue to issue the Certificate of Maintenance Review (CMR) and conduct the Annual Review of Airworthiness (ARA) in accordance with Sections 3.3 and 3.4 of BAR-AW Issue 01 Revision 01, respectively.
